- 1. Isa. 55:8-9 God's thoughts are better than man's thoughts.
 - a.I Cor. 1:25-31 God's foolishness is wiser than the wisest human.
 - b. Pro. 26:4-5 Do not answer someone by their basis of assumptions.
 - i. Pro. 30:5 Use the Bible as your basis for answers.
- 2.Isa. 55:10 God's knowledge and wisdom is seen in creation.
 - a.Pro. 3:19 God made and sustains the world with wisdom.
 - b.Col. 1:15-20 Creation was made through Christ making Christ man's creator and authority.
- 3. Isa. 55:11 Man may deny God's wisdom, but God's Word will accomplish what must be accomplished.
 - a.Col. 2:8-9 Christ is the authority giving believers the ability to battle mans philosophy.
 - b.Heb. 6:17-19 God will accomplish His purpose even through persecution.
 - c.Rom. 8:31-39 We will undergo persecution from wise people, but God has made us conquers.
 - i. Matt. 5:2-12 By joyful when receiving persecution.
